This includes positioning a vessel so that the prevailing wind or water current carries the vessel into the path of the whale at any point located within 400 yards of the whale. Boaters are obligated to disengage the transmission [Move away] of a vessel that is within 200 yards of a southern resident whale and boaters may not feed a southern resident whale. [X] Race instructions and pre-race skippers meeting should include information and reminders regarding COLREGS Rule 10 (Traffic Separation Schemes) and the importance of complying with such regardless of competitive position at the time.
